## Friday, October 23, 2009:

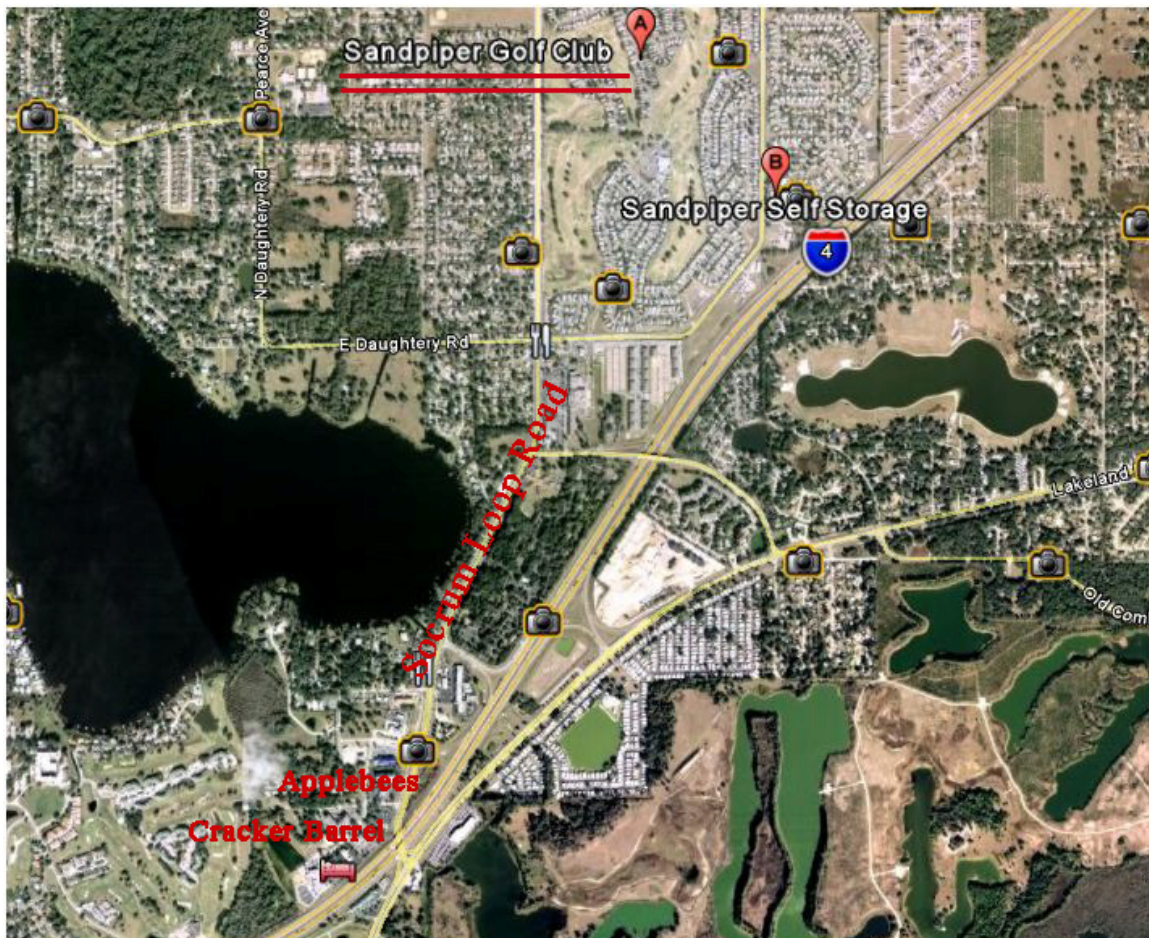


The order of the evening will be finger food, small pastries, coffee, etc... Setups will be furnished for those who bring their own adult beverage.

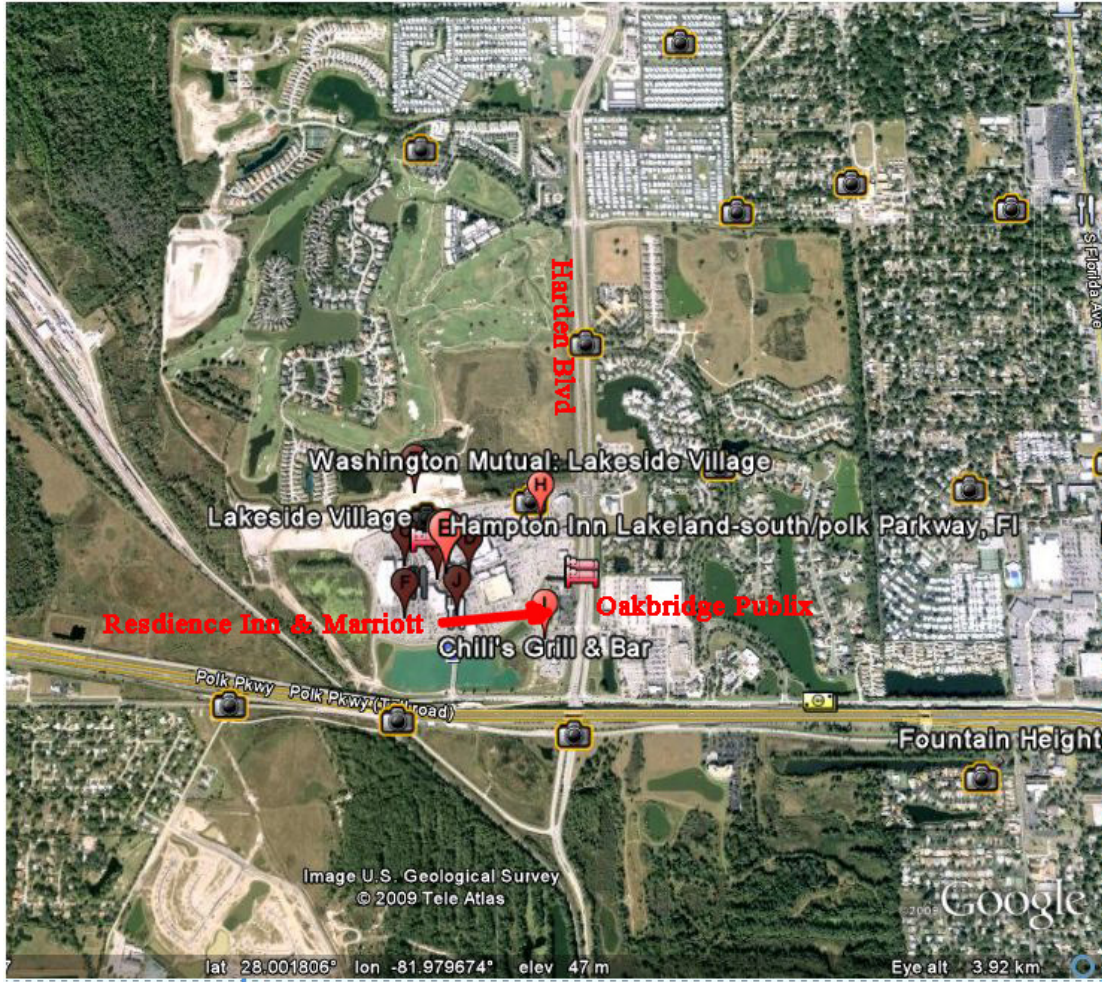


## Hotels:
